# CALL FOR CANDIDATES JUNIOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

# SUBMISSION BEFORE: December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2013

### 1. Program Overview & Eligibility Requirements

The Junior Research Fellowship Program supports Thai post doctorates graduated in 2009 or after, who intend to conduct a research project of two (2) to six (6) months within a French laboratory. All fields of research will be considered based on the criteria of excellence. The fellowship consists of a round trip ticket from Thailand to France, a monthly living allowance and the social insurance while staying in France.

#### 2. Selection Process

In order to identify the successful candidates, the selection committee will consider:

- The scientific and technical quality of the project
- The methodological rigour of the scientific approach
- The long term scientific and/or technical benefits
- The adequacy with the candidate background & knowledge

#### 3. Selection Schedule

Deadline for Submission: December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2013 Results at the end of January 2014 Departures can be from March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 Return trip has to be before December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014

#### 4. Documents to be provided:

- The filled and signed application form
- Passport Photocopy
- Up-to-date résumé stating the entire curriculum (including list of publications)
- Cover letter explaining motivations and interests in the project
- Copies of academic diploma
- Detailed description of the research project to be conducted in France
- Letter from the hosting laboratory in France

# Optional documents:

- Academic and/or professional recommendations
- Language proficiency certificates: French (TCF, DELF, DALF, academic degree,...) and/or English (TOEFL, TOEIC, etc.)
